# **REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS FORMAT**

The volume of abstracts – 1-2 full pages (MS Office Word 2003: A4 page format with 2 cm margins; font – Times New Roman, 14 pt, 1.0 spacing); without images, graphs, or source lists.

Title in BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS centered on the page,

on a new line – surname and initials of authors (bold, centered), the next line – full name of the institution, city, country, email (centered).

The abstracts should include the following sections: introduction (relevance), materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusions.

One file should contain one abstract. File names should correspond to the surname of the first author (e.g., Ivanov I.I.doc). If more than one abstract is provided by one author, files should be numbered with Arabic numerals (e.g., Ivanov I.I.1.doc).

The presentation should be formatted in Microsoft PowerPoint (file name according to the surname of the first author, e.g., "Ivanov I.I.", in Cyrillic).

After receiving the abstracts (presentation materials) and the registration card by email, if they comply with the established requirements and the conference topic and after acceptance for printing, authors will be sent a return letter of confirmation. If it is not received within 5 days after sending, please contact the contact person.

All abstracts are published in the author's edition. The author bears full responsibility for the content of the submitted materials.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not correspond to the conference topics and/or are formatted in violation of the requirements.

Abstracts of higher education seekers are published only in co-authorship with a scientific supervisor.
